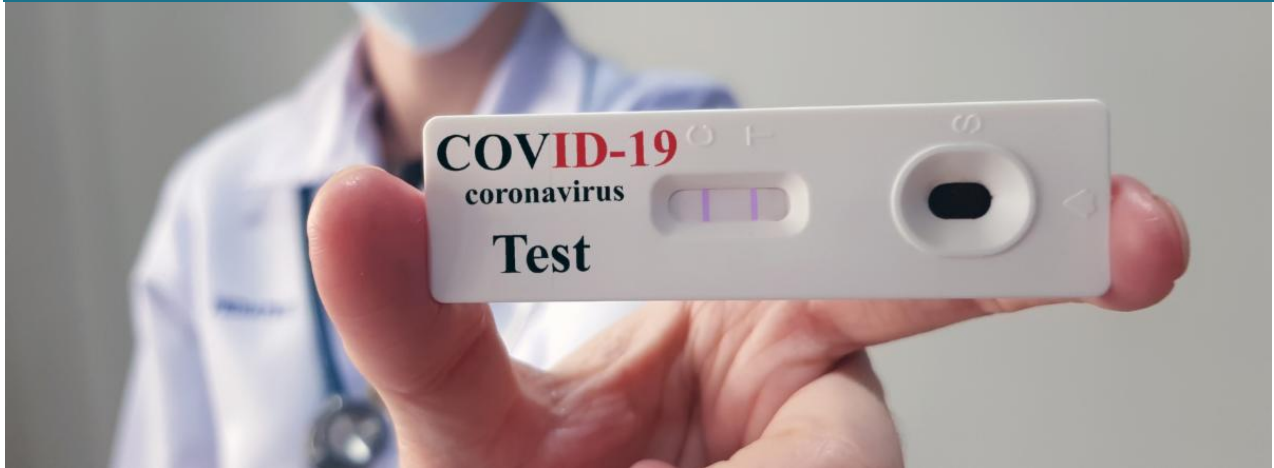

Opportunity Center Selected as COVID-19 Test Site

We are excited to announce a new partnership with HealthWorks for Northern Virginia to convert a portion of INMED's Family & Youth Opportunity Center in Sterling into a testing site for COVID-19, beginning on Thursday, May 28.

"This free service is the most important thing INMED USA can do at this time to serve our community," says Dr. Linda Pfeiffer, founder and CEO of INMED Partnerships for Children. "This partnership will help achieve healthcare parity for the most vulnerable children and families in our county."

HealthWorks provides high-quality and affordable medical, dental and behavioral health care for patients of all backgrounds, ages and income level. It was recently awarded a grant from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services to expand testing, particularly for low-income individuals.

Testing at the Opportunity Center will be by appointment only for both symptomatic and asymptomatic individuals and will be performed in a sealed-off area with a separate entrance. For more information on testing days and times, please contact theHealthWorks Leesburg office at 703-443-2000.

Healthy Families Loudoun (HFL) passed its annual independent evaluation with flying colors—for the 22nd consecutive year. Once again, our team of family support associates exceeded 100% of the state objectives and was named among the top 5 Healthy Families sites in Virginia.

"In FY 2019, HFL's outcome evaluation continued its track record of excellence," said evaluator Dr. Lee Huntington. "The children born to participating mothers



had normal births and full birth weights. Children received their expected immunizations and well baby visits and the parents demonstrated appropriate patterns of interactions with their children and had developmentally stimulating home environments."

An intensive, three-year program of INMED USA, HFL provides first-time, at-risk parents with in-home visitation, case management, education and access to critical resources to ensure a safe and nurturing home environment that fosters optimal child development.

"I want to take this opportunity to thank the entire HFL team for their commitment to excellence and

dedication to serve so many families, with such professionalism and dignity," said Maria Vasquez, director of INMED's Loudoun programs. "You are truly appreciated!"
